### CALVERTON CITIZENS ASSOCIATION (CCA) BOARD MEETING MINUTES

#### HIGHLIGHTS OF THE OCTOBER MEETING

The CCA board meet at TJ's because the police were unable to make it to the police substation. The CCA board paid for their own food and did not use any money out of the CCA treasury.

Treasurer's Report: Some residents have sent their CCA dues to the P.O. Box. Paid for security bond coverage for CCA officers.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

**Membership Committee:** Put the list and cards in the September newsletter. Block captains are collecting CCA dues.

Calverton Recreation Council: Has a slate of officers and will vote at their next general meeting.

**Nominating Committee:** The committee is gathering names and will accept names for the CCA Board of Directors.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

**Neighborhood Watch Training:** District VI police are encouraging communities to hold regular neighborhood watch meetings and to have neighborhood walks through the community. Calverton will hold a neighborhood walk in the spring.

**Original Owners celebration:** There is a committee that will send out the invites to the November 12 celebration.

**PEPCO tree removal:** The CCA will bring up the situation at Mary Lehman's Coffee on Friday.

**PG roads:** The CCA will bring up the road conditions at Mary Lehman's Coffee.

Galway/Fairland Sign: Repairs to the sign will cost \$1,370. Insurance for both signs, Galway/Fairland and Gracefield, will cost \$800.00 per year. These items will be discussed again at the November 6 meeting.

**Code violations:** We have volunteers who ride through the community in order to note violations and to take pictures. We will then notify each county of the violations.

Waterways clean up: The CCA will organize clean ups of our waterway areas in the spring. The Anacostia Watershed Society will help and we will set a date with them for the spring. Volunteers will be needed for the clean ups of our waterways.

Audit of the organization books: The audit will begin in November and will cover 2012 and 2013 years.

Lawsuit: The CCA is working with our insurance company regarding an injury that occurred during a CRC basketball function.

CCA shed: The CCA will pursue bids on the construction of the

foundation for the shed. We have the materials but we need the foundation to be built before the shed can be delivered. This item will be discussed at the November 6 meeting.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Mary Lehman's Coffee: The event takes place at

T.J.'s on Friday, October 10. Several CCA board members will be representing Calverton.

**Thefts from cars:** One board member mentioned that purses are still being stolen while women are pumping gas. If you plan to fill your car tank put your purse in the car trunk. You can pull it out when you get to your final destination.
