Call 911 and it is busy. Hang up and call again. Do not keep trying. Do not waste time trying to call 911 when it just keeps ringing and ringing and no one answers. This can be a matter of life and death. If it is busy again after a couple of tries, hang up and call the non-emergency police number or call 311.

DO NOT KEEP TRYING 911 IF IT KEEPS RINGING. JUST CALL ONE OF THE OTHER NUMBERS LISTED BELOW.

BULK PICKUP FOR BOTH COUNTIES

Prince George's County:

Special Bulk pick up for old appliances, scrap metal, old mattresses or furniture: Call 311 to schedule the pickup of your items.

Montgomery County:

Since Calverton residents who live in Montgomery County do not have county trash pickup, Montgomery County Special Bulk pickup is only for scrap metal. Call 311 the week before to schedule a pickup on your recycling day the next week.

If you have old mattresses or old furniture you have to call your trash hauler. Some people have Beltsville Refuse picking up their trash, so you need to call Beltsville Refuse about picking up your bulk items.
